

Plan of Enumeration and Listing Nomadic tribes (Bedouin):

The Nomadic tribes (Bedouin):

Bedouin means, for the purposes of census, all of traveling population who has no usual place of residence, live in tents or tents of hair and the like, and moving in the desert searching for pasture and water, or roaming from one place to another on the outskirts of towns or villages. Data has been taken from the Bedouin population similar to the rest population in the same records and forms of census.

Enumeration method:

1. The census committees in the administrative units limit the areas of presence the nomadic tribes geographically in their administrative units in coordination with the border police or other relevant groups prior to time of implementing census in about a month.
2. Listing areas of presence the nomadic tribes and enumerates their households in twenty days before census day according to the listing and enumeration card of the nomadic tribes (Bedouin).
3. The census committees in the administrative units where the nomadic tribes attendance forms listing and enumeration teams, and each team consists of two enumerators one of them have to be the director of the province sector (for this purpose exclusively) where the nomadic tribes exist and the other one from the administrative border police unit or the desert police or the local police or a guide has a sufficient knowledge of the region.
4. Orders of commissioning have been issued for listing and enumeration teams which mentioned in item (3) above, similar to the commissioning orders that will be issued to the managers of sectors or enumerators, and the Census Committee in the administrative unit has to provide the Census Committee in the governorate by copies of the commissioning orders of the assigned enumerators to enumerate and count the nomadic tribes who are existing in the geographical area of the administrative unit.
5. Listing and enumeration teams have been provided with a sufficient number of Bedouin census cards, census records, forms and organizational carts of listing and enumeration, based on the number of nomadic tribes' households.
6. Enumeration and listing teams enumerates and count nomadic tribes, according to the following:
 - a. Listing has been done according to the record of counts buildings, households and agricultural holdings based on its instructions where all required information has been filled in the record.

- b. Formation one team of listing and enumeration in the administrative unit where it will be given serial numbers in the (question No. 27) from the listing register for all of nomadic tribes households in the Administrative Unit, so the first households begin at number (1) and the second in (No. 2) and the third in (3) to the last household in the administrative unit.
 - c. After listing of households, the census has been carried out for the household according to the forms of population and housing register in accordance with their private instructions.
 - d. After fulfillment of the required data for the household in both forms of listing and enumeration, the sector director fills the special card of Bedouin census in the requested information and he must record his name, the number and date of the of census commissioning order then he must sign the card and pass it to the householder and inform the householder the necessitate of maintaining this card and bringing out it to the enumerators whom in charge of the census on the census day in order to avoid enumerating them more than once.
7. Draw the preliminary results of the nomadic tribes (Bedouin) according to preliminary adopted schedules results immediately after completion from listing and enumerating them in a week before the census day and is taken into account the following when the schedules have being organized:
- a. Organize preliminary adopted schedules results in accordance with its special instructions.
 - b. The Committee of Census in the administrative unit, where the nomadic tribes exists, audits and checks the listing and enumeration population records, and the schedules of preliminary results , then be sent all to the Commission census in the governorate.
8. The Committee of General the population Census in the governorate collects of all the forms and schedules of preliminary results for the nomadic tribes in all administrative units to form conclusions it at the governorate level and send it to the central census operation room with the other results of census.

Instruction of Enumeration and census card for the nomadic tribes (Bedouin)

Components Card

The Card consists of a cardboard has two colors and divisions are:

Section A: (Blue Color)

After the completion of listing and enumeration process of the households, The Sector Director fills the columns that special for this section and shall be delivered with the record of listing and population and its supplements to the head of the Administrative Unit.

This section contains the following columns:

1. The Region: Record the name of Region for Kurdistan governorates
2. The Governorate: Record the name of the governorate.
3. The Administrative Unit: Record the name of the administrative unit, the District and Sub-district.
4. The name of householder: Record the name of householder in it.
5. The name of the Sector Director: Record in it the name of the sector Director.
6. The date of listing and enumeration: Record in it the date of listing and enumeration of the Bedouin household.
7. Stamp of the administrative unit, if it's District or Sub-district.

Section B: (The Red Color)

After the completion of listing and enumeration process of the households, The Sector Director fills the columns that special for this section and shall be handed over to the householder to maintain this card, and bringing out it when he has been asked; this section contains the following columns:

Columns from (1-4) Record in it the name of the region, the governorate, the district and the Sub-district.

Column (5) Record in it the number and date of the administrative order of formation the team of listing and enumeration the Bedouin.

Column (6) Record in it the name of sector Director and his signature.

Column (7) Record the date of listing and Enumeration.

Column (8) The name of the householder.

Column (9) The stamp of administrative unit.

While the number of card must be set up by the sector manager who has listed and enumerated Bedouin in both sections A and B.
